I'm old enough to remember some men and women who God used mightily to keep Indiana Yearly Meeting anchored to Christ during times of cultural change and upheaval. Paul and Madeline Todd were two of my heroes from days gone by. In her later years, Madeline's vision was deteriorating. I'm told she once saw someone that looked familiar in a restaurant, only to realize later that she was looking into a mirror. I feel the same way when I consider the culture in which we live. It seems familiar, but it's hard to recognize as ours.

Last weekend I attended a retreat

where the featured speaker was a Christian attorney from an organization that focuses on defending religious liberties. He cited the differences between cultural changes, cultural shifts, and a cultural revolution. Someone has described three characteristics of a cultural revolution: 1. What was condemned is now celebrated. 2. What was celebrated is now condemned. 3. Those refusing to celebrate are condemned. Sound familiar?

The book of Esther tells the story of a young woman in a culture that

had turned hostile toward her and her people. Rather than being a victim of her circumstances, however, God used her as an instrument of deliverance. It was Mordecai who said to her in Esther 4:14, "And who knows but what you have come to this royal position for such a time as this." Have you ever considered that it is no accident that you and I are alive in such a time as this? How is God using you and your church as instruments of deliverance in this culture?
