Yearly Meeting is a term used by members of the Religious Society of Friends, or Quakers, to refer to an organization composed of constituent meetings or Churches within a geographical area. The constituent meetings are called Monthly Meetings. "Monthly" and "Yearly" refer to how often the body meets to make decisions. Monthly Meetings are local congregations which hold worship on Sunday. Yearly meetings meet once yearly for a group business meeting and spiritual gathering, with organizational committee meetings, workshops, and other activities being held throughout the year.

Indiana Yearly Meeting was formed in 1821 and now comprises 44 meetings and 2 preparative meetings within Indiana, Michigan and Ohio. 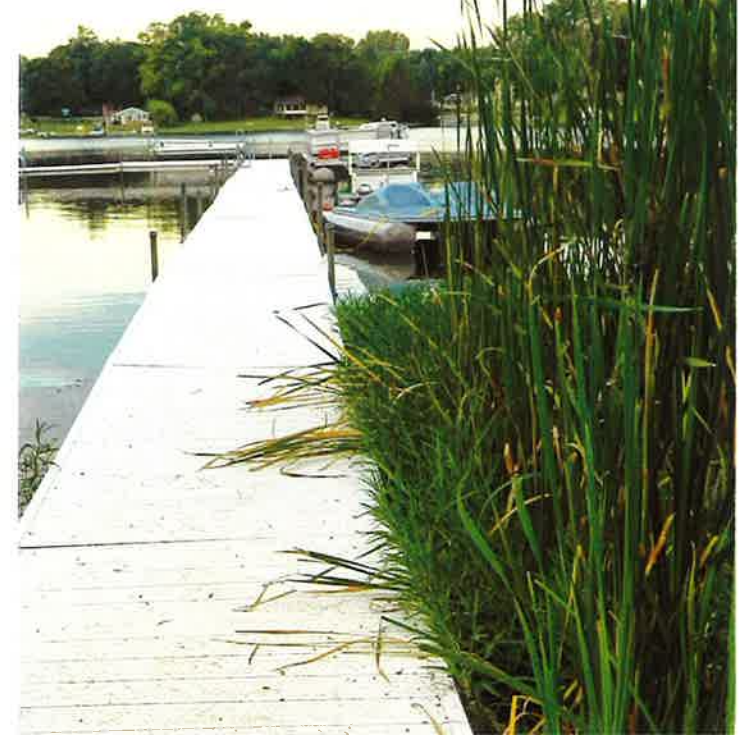
